 - Use appropriate language.
 - Do not take or use someone else's belongings.
- 3. Follow directions of Camp Courageous staff & volunteers:
 - Your safety is our top priority.
 - Always stay with the group.
 - Always ask permission before leaving the group.
- 4. All Camp Courageous trips are tobacco, alcohol, and drug free.
 - This will benefit the health and safety of everyone around and yourself.
- 5. Remember to always have fun, keep a positive attitude, and enjoy your vacation with Camp Courageous Travel!!!

Travel Policies:

- Camp Courageous does not provide campers, volunteers, or staff with traveler's insurance.
 - ⇒ Therefore, if you would like to purchase individual traveler's insurance for your trip, you must contact your current insurance broker or seek a reputable insurer online.
- If a camper cannot continue with a trip due (ex. Due to illness, injury, behavior etc.), the traveler's guardian and/or facility will be contacted.
 - ⇒ Arrangements will be made to send the traveler home by whatever means of transportation that is deemed appropriate for the circumstance. The traveler is responsible for all fees.
- Trips will operate in any weather except when the weather is deemed unsafe.
 - ⇒ Cancellations and rescheduling due to unsafe weather are made at the discretion of Camp Courageous.
 - ⇒ Camp Courageous reserves the right to modify the itinerary for the safety of the travelers and staff.
- If a trip is cancelled by Camp Courageous due to unsafe weather, a prorated amount may be issued as a credit for future use.
- If a third party is involved in our travels and cancels an activity or event due to unsafe weather or other unforeseen circumstances, we must adhere to their cancellation policy.
- Alcohol, drug, and tobacco products are strictly prohibited on all trips
- At the discretion of Camp Courageous, new travel campers may be asked to attend a day, short overnight trip, or attend a camp date at Camp Courageous prior to attending a week-long trip.
